When did you receive your first communion? Can you recall any special time when you received communion? What do the bread and wine mean to you? Have you ever been betrayed by someone? How do you think the other disciples felt? What does 'eat the Passover' mean for Jesus? What does this passage Lk 22:24-38 teach us about pride, power and prestige? What are the qualities of leadership? In what ways have we been tested about our faith? Have we ever denied Jesus? How did Peter feel? Is there a way back? What was your first understanding of the cross? What was the ultimate charge brought against Jesus? Why does Luke only focus on one criminal? Read Hebrews 10:19-25 and think why does Luke record details about the death of Jesus? What can we do to make the message of the cross relevant to the world? As a church or as individuals?
